

# A Business Continuity Case Study

## The Challenge

The company did a review of their business critical systems and realised that they were in an extremely vulnerable position. Whilst they had a basic data backup system in place in case of flood or fire, their backups were vulnerable to the much more likely scenario of a cyber attack. Their current backups were also focused on data preservation only, not on business continuity.

A couple of hours down time would lose them tens of thousands of pounds, they needed a seamless business continuity solution.

## The Solution
